PROPERTY OWNER PROXY

Return on or before March 21, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.

Section 720.306, Florida Statutes, authorizes members the right to vote in person or by proxy on business discussed at the annual membership meeting. To be valid, the proxy must be dated, state the date, time, and place of the meeting for which it was given, and be signed by the authorized person who executed the proxy. The proxy is effective only for the specific meeting given. The proxy automatically expires two months from its date of execution unless otherwise specified in the proxy and may be revoked at any time at the pleasure of the person who executes it. The Property Owner Proxy may be used to establish a quorum so the meeting can be conducted.

The proxy allows you to appoint another person to vote on your behalf in the event you are unable to attend the meeting. You may appoint the secretary of the association (or if the secretary is unable to attend, any person the secretary designates), or you may appoint any other person who will be attending the meeting.
